

Activity: Bike Police

Target Group: grades 3-6

Recommended Size: 20-60 children

Time Requirement: 15-20 minutes

Supplies Needed: a student with a bicycle and a helmet (optional), blank checklist and pencil, cycling skills booklets

Space Requirements: a large open space and enough room for all children to see what is taking place (inside or out)

Safety Considerations: make sure that children are operating their bikes properly while indoors

Rules:

1. Each child is given a blank 'Bike police' checklist.
2. Children will then fill out the checklist based on the key elements of a bike as identified by the leader.
3. Children can then use the checklist to inspect another child's bike, and make sure that all necessary items are present, or they can take the checklist home to check their own bikes, or moms and dad's bike.

Learning Outcomes: This will reinforce the necessary parts to have on a safe operating bicycle.
