Aisle Infringement fine \$500.00

The show management of the Toronto International Bicycle Show has been forced to introduce an aisle infringement fine of \$500.00 for the following reasons:

- Complaints from the Fire Marshal and the National Trade Centre's Building Management
- The show's Insurance Company has warned that claims would be rejected due to this problem
- Complaints from exhibitors regarding other exhibitors infringing on the aisles
- Constant battle between exhibitors that infringe on the aisles and show management
- Aisle infringement creates over crowding for the consumers attending the show.

We have attempted for many years to control the infringement of the aisles by speaking to exhibitors with very little success. All of the above is very negative and spoils a very positive show and we have been left with no other alternative but implement the following procedure:

Procedure - Show staff will check for aisle infringement and exhibitors that are infringing on the aisles will receive a warning notice, which will provide the exhibitor an opportunity to correct the problem. If this problem is not corrected, we will provide you with an invoice for \$500.00
